Sunday afternoon for pleasure drivers and competitors, Hale Farm & Village will have a cones demonstration, followed by a parade through the historic Hale Village.

Throughout the weekend visitors can see horses of different breeds, carriages of different styles and take in the sound of horse hooves moving tapping through the grounds all surrounded by the serenity of the Farm in Cuyahoga Valley during this event as competitors will be traveling through the valley and Hale Farm & Village.

Admission is \$10 adults/seniors. \$5 children (age 3-12).
